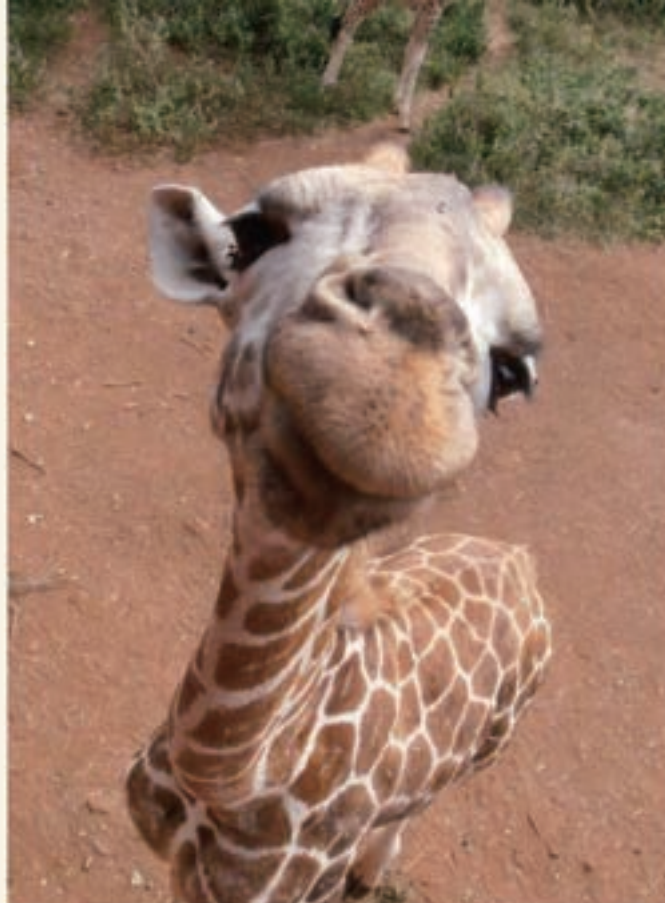

# COACHELLA 2026

**Coachella Valley Music and Arts Festival 2026** took place across two weekends in April at the Empire Polo Club in Indio, California, continuing its tradition as one of the world's most influential music festivals. 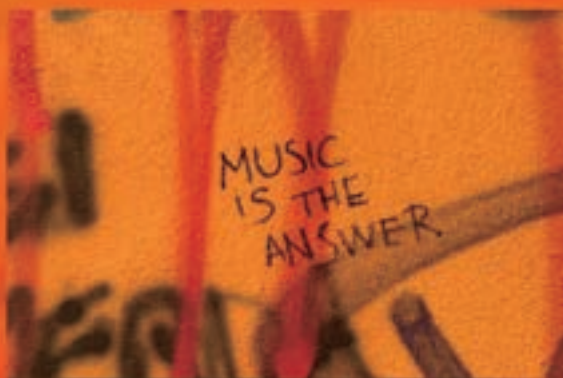

# Learn Music Genres with Songs You Know

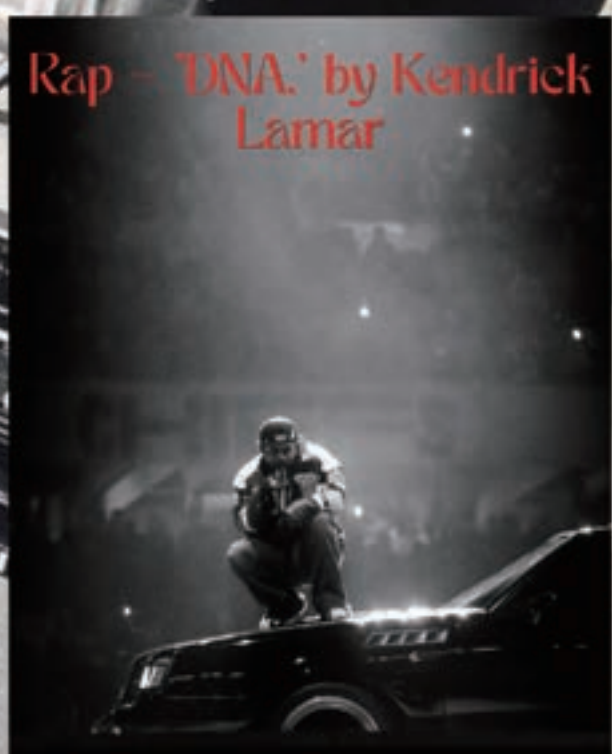

## Hip Hop – 'Flashing Lights' by Kanye West

Hip-hop is more than just music. It's a culture that started in New York in the 1970s. It includes DJing, rapping, dancing, and graffiti art. "Flashing Lights" by Kanye West is a great hip-hop song from 2007. The beat uses strings from an orchestra, drums, and keyboards. It sounds rich and moody. 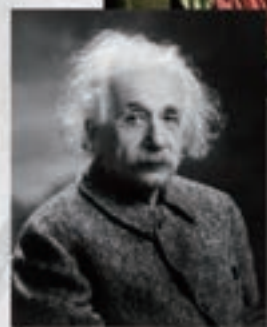

For the longest time, I've avoided Homestuck like the plague. I've heard nightmares about the fandom; how insufferably toxic it was. But that was all. I've never actually read it. Until, during the holidays, I sat down and did.

Never would I have thought that I would become a Homestuck fan.

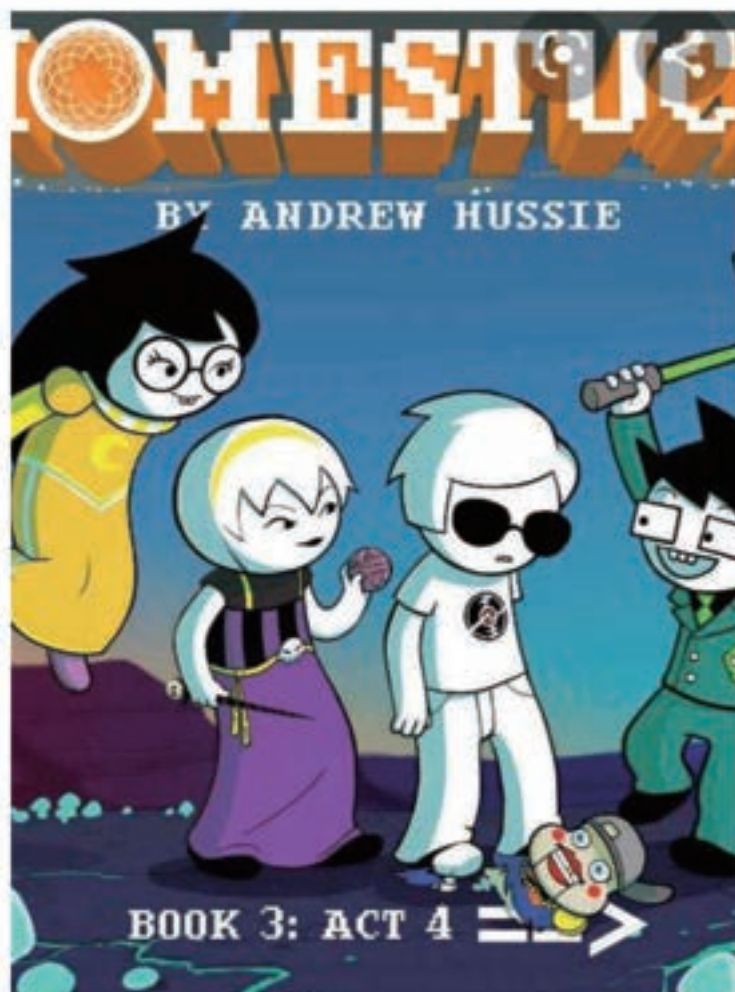
To kick things off it's worth mentioning some key points of Homestuck:

- It was written by Andrew Hussie, first released in 2009, and continued serialisation until 2016.
- Be prepared to read a lot; this isn't like your traditional comic. In fact, it's more like a visual novel, having only one to a few panels per page, and blocks of text underneath.
- Aside from being a comic, it's also an animation, a game, a book, and an anime(!)
- Brace yourself for flashing lights.

## 5C Mandy To Ka Man

The story starts off simple: a kid getting a game as a birthday present. Then, it evolves into RPG battles with parents/guardians; games ending/saving the world; befriending/dating otherworldly species; creating a new universe. Worst of all: messy teen relationships!

Underneath its juvenile humour, Homestuck has a genuinely mind-blowing plot. Emphasis on 'mind-blowing'. It's not just about four friends playing a game. It's about growing up, how hard it is, and how nobody understands.



Most stories follow a straightforward line. Homestuck, on the other hand, is a tangle of wires, looped around each other, that eventually leads to the same end. While reading, you have to keep track of multiple characters' perspectives (that switch without warning), multiple concurrent timelines, time travelling paradoxes, your mum being your sister/child/descendant all at once, and troll romance.

At first, I let my prejudices regarding the fandom influence me, thinking I was just going to hate it. But once I got past that, it was exactly my thing: the recontextualizations, the character writing, the mind-blowing content, the queerness, the witty prose, the T3XT1NG STYL3, the animations, the surprisingly skilful art... It's everything I've ever wanted, and more. I'm surprised I've slept on this, and never grown up with it.

I could write at least a 10-page essay on Homestuck, but alas, I'm confined by the word limit of this magazine. That's how much I like it.

I recommend Homestuck to those who like experimental fiction, bad movies, teen angst, questionable characters, awesome women, grey trolls, puppets... Basically everyone, except for photo-sensitive people; the flashing lights in the animations are NOT to be taken 'light'ly.

The comic starts off slow at first. You'll be wondering why nothing's happening in the first 100 pages. But when it really picks up, you'll read all 8000+ pages of Homestuck on homestuck.com - gladly and even wish it would never end!

# The Golden Era of Marvel Studios

Are you a Marvel fan like I am? Well, if you are, then you must have heard of the upcoming movie *Avengers: Doomsday*. It's the name on everyone's lips, but before we get swept up in the new wave of hype, I want to be real with you: since *Avengers: Endgame*, it feels like Marvel has completely lost its way.

We've watched the MCU enter a noticeable downfall, where the sheer volume of content often overshadowed the quality of the storytelling. While we've had some undeniable bright spots—like the multiversal chaos of *Spider-Man: No Way Home*, the sheer irreverence of *Deadpool & Wolverine*, and the gritty, grounded anticipation for *Thunderbolts*—the overall narrative glue that once held this universe together has felt dangerously thin.



Before the experimental shifts of Phase 4 and Phase 5, Marvel Studios reached a peak that felt like a permanent cultural throne: the Infinity Saga. This was a time when Marvel absolutely ruled the 2010s blockbuster movie era. Every release was an "event." Whether it was the mind-bending, mystical visuals introduced in *Doctor Strange* or the vibrant, high-stakes comedy of *Thor: Ragnarok*, the studio had a Midas touch. They weren't just making movies; they were defining the global cinematic language, creating a decade where superheroes weren't just a genre—they were the main event.

If you're a Marvel enthusiast just like I am, you've probably noticed a pattern in the movies that define this "Golden Era." My personal favourites—*Captain America: The Winter Soldier*, *Civil War*, *Infinity War*, and *Endgame*—weren't just successful; they were transformative.

And they all share the same directors: The Russo Brothers. These four films represent the pinnacle of Marvel's storytelling because they balanced massive, world-ending stakes with deeply personal character arcs.



We are standing at a crossroads. By reuniting the Russo Brothers with the original heart and soul of the Avengers, Marvel is clearly trying to reclaim its crown. They are moving away from the "quantity over quality" era and heading back into a time where every frame feels intentional and every character moment feels earned. For those of us who grew up with these heroes, *Avengers: Doomsday* isn't just another sequel; it's a promise that the "Golden Era" isn't just a memory—it's about to begin all over again.

The Russos have this unique ability to handle twenty-plus heroes without losing the emotional core of the story. It is exactly this "Russo Magic" that makes their return for *Avengers: Doomsday* feel like the first real step toward fixing what went wrong. But the directors aren't the only ones coming home to save the day. The recent reveals have confirmed the return of the two pillars that built this house, though with some massive twists. First, there's the seismic news of Robert Downey Jr. returning to the fold. However, instead of the heroic Iron Man we mourned, he's taking on the mantle of Victor von Doom. Having the man who started the hero era now portray its most complex antagonist is a masterstroke of casting. It creates a psychological tension for both the characters and the audience—seeing that face, but knowing it represents a threat greater than Thanos ever was. Then, we have the news that truly carries the emotional weight: Chris Evans is back.

But here is the part that matters most: this isn't a multiverse variant or a "What If?" gimmick. This is the original Steve Rogers. This is the man who lived through the 1940s, led the Avengers through their darkest hours, and finally sought a quiet life with Peggy Carter. Reports suggest he's returning with a rugged, "Nomad-style" look—long hair and a beard—signalling that he's stepping out of a well-earned retirement because the world is in such dire need of his leadership. Seeing the original Steve Rogers return to face a villain with the face of his former friend is the kind of high-stakes drama that defined the 2010s.

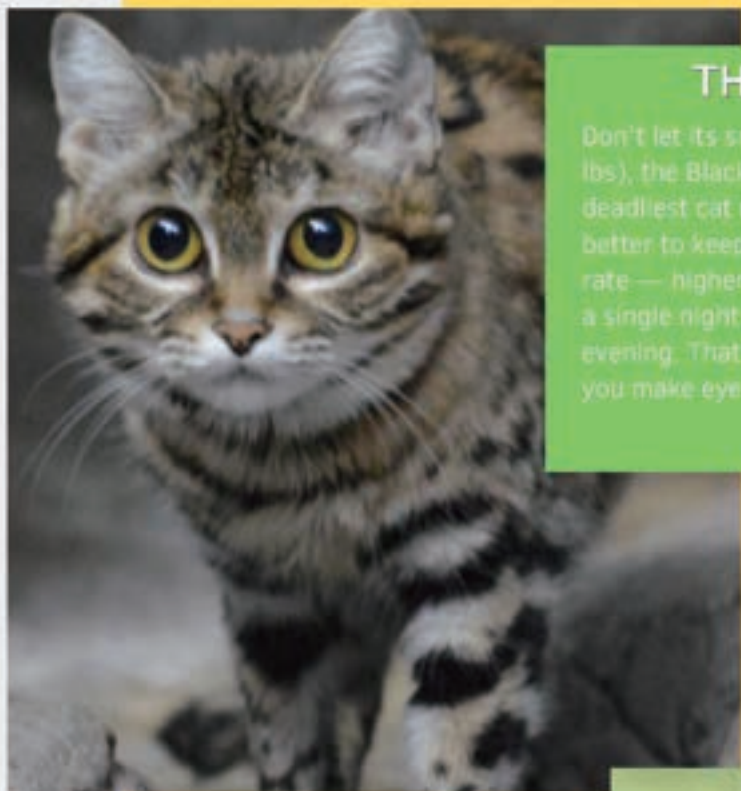

## The Pallas's Cat (Manul)

The Pallas's Cat is often called the "original grumpy cat" due to its flat face and permanently annoyed expression. Native to the high-altitude grasslands of Central Asia, it has the thickest fur of any cat, which helps it survive freezing temperatures. Its most distinctive trait is its special physical feature. Unlike most cats, its pupils are round rather than vertical slits. It looks a lot like a tiger and is insanely cool. Not only does its appearance resemble a tiger, but its demeanour also matches tigers by around 90 percent. Although listed as Near Threatened, these cats are incredibly elusive and masters of camouflage.





## THE BLACK-FOOTED CAT

Don't let its small size fool you. Weighing only about 1.5 kg (3.3 lbs), the Black-footed Cat of Southern Africa is officially the deadliest cat on Earth. It looks insanely adorable, but I guess it's better to keep your distance from it. It has a 60% hunting success rate—higher than lions or leopards. It can travel up to 20 miles in a single night to find prey, eating up to 14 small animals per evening. That means you could become its meal in seconds once you make eye contact with it. ## THE CHOW CHOW

Hailing from China, the Chow Chow is one of the world's oldest dog breeds. Historically, they were all-purpose dogs—used for hunting, herding, and guarding imperial palaces. Their most famous feature is a deep blue-black tongue. Legend says they licked the sky while it was being painted; biologically, it's a unique genetic trait. They possess a thick "ruff" around the neck, giving them a lion-like appearance. They are often described as "cat-like." While they are fiercely loyal to their family, they are also aloof, reserved, and sometimes suspicious of strangers. If you are a dog lover, I think your heart will melt when you see them!



## THE SCHNAUZERS

The Schnauzer family (Miniature, Standard, and Giant) originated in Germany. They were bred to be farm dogs, capable of everything from catching rats to pulling small carts. 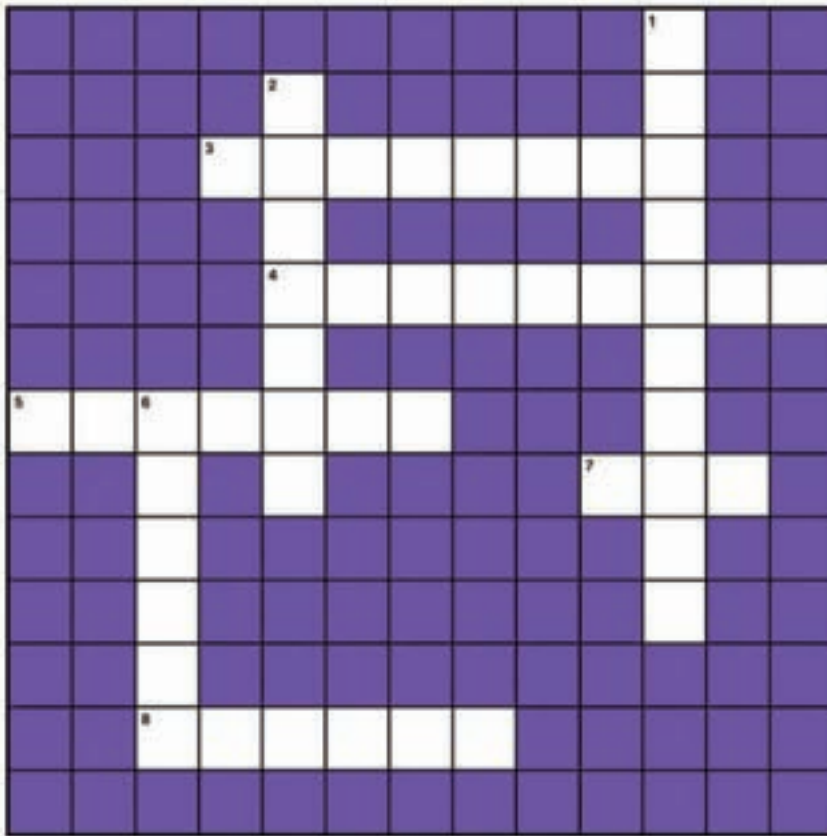
